

Day 1 : Arrival transfer from Delhi airport to hotel

Arrive Delhi by flight (To be advised)

After immigration and customs check meet our representative outside who will transfer you to the hotel Check in at hotel. Overnight at hotel

Day 2 : Delhi

Breakfast at hotel

City Sightseeing tour **NEW DELHI** - the new capital designed By Sir Edward Lutyens. Drive down the main avenue, the Impressive Rajpath to the World War I memorial arch, the India **Palace, the Rashtrapati Bhavan** and the secretariat buildings the centre of all government activity. Visit **Humayun's**

Tomb built in 1565 AD by his grieving widow Haji Begum, The **Qutub Minar**, 72 metres high and the ruins of **Quwat-ul Eslam (Light of Islam) Mosque** and Delhi's most curious antique, the uncorroded **Iron Pillar**, which dates back to the 4th century AD Visit the **Birla Laxmi Narayan Temple** with its many idols.

Visit Akshardham temple The main monument, at the center of the complex, is 141-foot (43 m) high, 316-foot (96 m) wide, and 356-foot (109 m) long and is covered top to bottom with carved details of flora, fauna, dancers, musicians, and deities. Designed in accordance with ancient Vedic text known as the Sthapatya Shasta, it features a blend of architectural styles from across India.^{[8][9]} It is constructed entirely from Rajasthani pink sandstone and Italian Carrara marble, and has no support from steel or concrete

Day 3: New Delhi - Jaipur

After breakfast checkout from hotel and drive to Jaipur (265 km)

Arrive Jaipur proceed to hotel

City Sightseeing tour Visit to the **City Palace**. In the heart of the old city is the former royal residence built in a blend of the Rajasthani and Mughal styles. Adjacent to the entrance to the city palace is the observatory or **Jantar Mantar**, begun by Baisingh in 1728. At first glance, Jantar Mantar appears to be just a curious collection of sculptures but, in fact each construction has a specific purpose, such as measuring the positions of stars, altitudes and azimuths, or calculating eclipses to **Hawa Mahal** also called as the Palace of Winds- is one of Jaipur's major landmarks, although it is actually little than a facade. It's a five storey building and if you climb to the top of Hawa -Mahal you can have an excellent view of the city. Overnight at hotel

Day 4: Jaipur

Breakfast at hotel

Visit Amber fort with its honey colored fortress-palace in The Aravalli Hills which can be mounted by elephant.

It has been described as “the sleeping beauty of Rajasthan”.

The sombre exteriors belies the richness of the royal apartments Which open on to striking views of the gorge it also possesses A Chamber of Mirrors.

Day 5: Jaipur / Agra

After breakfast checkout from hotel and drive to Agra (233 km)

Visit Taj Mahal - the greatest love story ever told. On the death Of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, in wild extravagance, Shahjahan built her this memorial. 20,000 men laboured for Over 17 years to build this white marble and precious stone, overnight **at hotel**.



Day 6 :Agra/ Noida

After breakfast checkout from hotel and drive to Noida (165 km)
Arrive Noida and proceed to hotel .Overnight at hotel.

Day 7: Noida / Rishikesh

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Haridwar (196 km)Arrive Rishikesh and proceed to hotel City sightseeing and Aarti, **Rishikesh** along with Haridwar, has been known to Hindu religion as one of the most revered centers of pilgrimage. For relaxation of body and mind, Rishikesh has always held an appeal. Overnight at hotel.



Day 8: Rishikesh /Haridwar


Breakfast at hotel and drive to Haridwar Arrive Haridwar

City sightseeing tour Visit the Gateway of India, Mumbai's principal Landmark. This arch of yellow basalt was erected on the waterfront in 1924 to commemorate King George V's visit to this colony in 1911. Drive past the Bombay High Court built in Gothic style and the Old Secretariat. The ornamental university building with its 280 ft. high Rajabhai Clock Tower, the ornate Victoria Terminus, the colourful Crawford Market, the Flora Fountain in the large bustling square at the heart of the city, the Prince of Wales Museum which houses a varied collection of China-ware, miniature paintings and sculpture. Afghan Church built in memory of those who fell in the First Afghan War. Drive



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along the Marine Drive which is known as the Queen's Necklace. View the memorial to Haji Ali, a Muslim Saint This unusual shrine stands on an island 500m out at sea and is linked by a causeway to the mainland. Malabar Hill with the Kamla Nehra Park. Visit the Hanging Gardens which offer a splendid view of the city, and drive pas the Mahalaxmi Temple. Stop at the Jain Temple and also visit Mani Bhavan where Mahatma Gandhi stayed during his visits to Bombay. Drive past the Taraporewalla Aquarium.

Evening free for shopping Overnight at hotel
